## NOMINATION FOR MEMBERSHIP

The Society welcomes to active membership any person who is interested in its objects, and who holds a bachelor's degree in microbiology or a related field (or who has had training and experience equivalent to that represented by a bachelor's degree).

The Society has seven scientific journals: (1) *Journal of Bacteriology* (JB), in which are found original communications on all branches of fundamental microbiology; (2) *Applied Microbiology* (AM), which contains original communications dealing mainly with industrial and applied applications of microbiology; (3) *Journal of Virology* (JVI), which is devoted to articles on fundamental knowledge of viruses of bacteria, plants, and animals; (4) *Infection and Immunity* (IAI), which contains original communications on all aspects of medical microbiology and immunology; (5) *Antimicrobial Agents and Chemotherapy* (AAC), which includes all aspects of antimicrobial agents and chemotherapy, including cancer chemotherapy; (6) *Bacteriological Reviews* (BR), a quarterly review journal containing articles on subjects of current microbiological interest, and (7) *International Journal of Systematic Bacteriology* (IJSB), a quarterly journal devoted to bacterial nomenclature, published for the IAMS. In addition, the Society publishes the monthly *ASM NEWS*, which is sent to all members and contains news and announcements of concern to all microbiologists.

The Society holds an Annual Meeting where the latest results of research in all branches of microbiology are presented, and where members have opportunities to become acquainted and to discuss work in progress. The abstracts of papers presented at the meetings are published.

The annual Interscience Conference on Antimicrobial Agents and Chemotherapy provides opportunity for an exchange of information among all scientific disciplines interested in chemotherapeutic agents and infectious disease.

The minimum annual membership fee is \$20 which includes \$5 dues, \$2 for subscription to *ASM News*, and \$13 for a year's subscription to any one of the Society's journals listed in No. 1 below. You must fill in No. 1. For additional journals, fill in No. 2.

Memberships are initiated and renewed as of January 1 each year. Unless there are directions to the contrary, membership nominations received prior to November 1 will be credited to the current year, and back issues of the selected publications for the current year will be furnished. Nominations received after November 1 will become effective on the following January 1.
